- The unemployment rate for families with a student in school is 39%.
- 74% of all students enrolled in the GJSD qualify for free or reduced lunch.
- 45% of all individuals under the age of 18 in the Greater Johnstown School District live in poverty.
- The city was declared a Distressed City and has one of the highest unemployment rates in Pennsylvania
- GJSD is in the bottom 10% of school districts in college entrance rates and in the bottom 10% in college retention rates.
